

6.3. Collaboration with the Gastronomy Chair of Andalusia

The Gastronomy Chair of Andalusia was created in 2009 thanks to an agreement between the University of Cordoba and the Bodegas Campos Foundation.

The mission of the Gastronomy Chair of Andalusia is to disseminate and integrate the culture and culinary knowledge in society, while strengthening ties between the universities of Andalusia, business, government, tourism and hotel and restaurant management schools as well as agents of the Andalusian knowledge system through close collaboration with professionals and experts.
